

Hurdler's Lane – Councillors Blanchard and Cox continue to press Warwickshire Rural Housing Association to rectify problems caused by bad workmanship on the houses in Hurdler's Lane and have recently focused upon examples of showers not properly installed, windows that need refitting and damp-proof course issues.

Speed Watch Group – more volunteers are needed in order to establish the Group, which will monitor the speed of traffic in the village. Please contact Councillor Sue Main, without any commitment, to ask what is involved. This is a very important initiative to improve safety in the village and you are encouraged to participate. It will not involve a great deal of your time.

Village Hall – the Village Hall Management Committee has attempted to address the issue of inconsiderate parking that has arisen when large functions are held in the Village Hall. Booking conditions have been amended to ensure that users of the Village Hall control parking and recent experience indicates substantial improvement.

Kings Lane traffic – members of the public expressed their concern about the volume and high speed of traffic along Kings Lane and asked whether action could be taken to reduce the speed limit from 60mph and to provide footpaths for the safety of pedestrians, particularly bearing in mind that part of Kings Lane is a section of the Monarch's Way. Also raised was the danger of cars queuing on the A46 to turn right into Kings Lane. The Parish Council will raise all these issues with Anne Parry, County Councillor.
