

**Hurdler's Lane** – gas central heating has been installed in all 8 Housing Association houses, which is a great improvement. However, Councillor Cox will send to Warwickshire Rural Housing Association a list of all the serious outstanding issues relating to these houses which remain unresolved. Councillors Blanchard and Cox are having a meeting with the Housing Association and will address these issues.

**Playing Field Working Group** – as a result of the Open Day held on 2 February, the Working Group received over 70 forms containing ideas for the future use of the playing field. The responses are being reviewed and a questionnaire will be sent to all residents in order to obtain their views regarding the playing field.

However, the members of the Working Group, who are not Parish Councillors, have concerns regarding the process and these concerns need to be addressed and resolved before progress can be made towards creating a really excellent facility for the benefit of all residents.

**Speed Watch Group** – more volunteers are needed in order to establish the Group, which will be responsible for monitoring the speed of traffic in the village. This is a very worthwhile initiative to improve safety in the village and you are encouraged to participate. Please contact Councillor Sue Main, without commitment, to find out what is involved.

**Village Hall** – following the recent installation of the new toilets, quotations are being obtained for the development of the store room.

Meanwhile, applications continue to be made for funding to finance the remaining proposals for the improvement of the Village Hall. This is an extremely challenging task and all donations and any other assistance from residents would be greatly appreciated.

**Pavements in the village** – the poor condition of some pavements in the village has been noted and the appropriate authority will be informed and requested to rectify the problems.
