**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER**

**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 SECTION 257 AND  
PARAGRAPH 7 OF SCHEDULE 14**

**SD146 SNITTERFIELD (PART OF)**

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2018**

On 1 May 2018, Stratford-on-Avon District Council confirmed the Order for the above.

The effect of the Order, confirmed under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended), will divert that part of Public Path SD146 Snitterfield from Point A (grid reference 420960 258963), as indicated on the Order Plan running generally in a south south east direction for a distance of approximately 20 metres to Point B (grid reference 420964 258945), then running generally in a south westerly direction for approximately 80 metres to Point C (grid reference 420903 258884), then running generally in a west south west direction for approximately 20 metres to Point D (grid reference 420888 258883) AND there shall be a replacement path for that part of Public Path SD146 from Point A, running generally in a south westerly direction for a distance of approximately 112 metres to Point D. Works to the Public Path and installation of gates at Points A and D shall be in accordance with a landscape plan associated with planning reference 17/02840/VARY. The new route shall have a width of 2 metres.

A copy of the Order and Order Plan may be seen free of charge at the Council Offices, Elizabeth House, Church Street, Stratford-upon-Avon between 8.45 a.m. to 5.15 p.m. Monday to Wednesdays and 8.45 to 5.00 pm Thursdays to Fridays (except Bank Holidays). Copies of the Order and Order Plan may be bought there at the price of £5.00.

The order came into force on the 1 May 2018 but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to the Act.
